

IDENTIFYING AND RESPONDING TO ELDER ABUSE:
THE VITAL ROLE OF COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS PROFESSIONALS

CONTINUING EDUCATION AND TESTING INFORMATION

Each of the four modules of this distance learning training program provides an opportunity for participants to earn 1.5 continuing education contact hours. A 10-question test has been developed specifically for each module, each of which may be taken either manually or online and as often as desired. A score of at least 70% is required pass the test and receive credit for any given module.

Each module will be recorded during the live broadcast and may be viewed on APPA's Website within two weeks of the air date. Whether participants view the live or the recorded trainings, APPA will certify continuing education contact hours for the life of this project (currently scheduled to end on December 31, 2007). Beyond the project's end date, APPA will continue to host the recorded programs on its Web site for as long as is practicable; however, contact hours will no longer be offered.

Online Tests (Recommended)

For fastest results, take tests online. Scoring is automatic and if you achieve 70% or more, you will be able to immediately print your personalized certificate for the 1.5 continuing education contact hours applicable to that module.

In addition, online tests provide immediate feedback for each answer as it is submitted. Each time you click "submit answer," a screen will pop up to let you know whether your choice was correct or, if incorrect, what the best choice would have been.

Manual Tests

Manual tests will require approximately three weeks to process. Those who score at least 70% will be emailed a personalized certificate for 1.5 continuing education contact hours; those who score less than 70% will receive an email notifying them that they did not pass and will need to retake the test to receive credit.
