In the aftermath of Hurricane Harvey, the Houston Food Bank has been distributing massive amounts of food to various charities. The Houston Food Bank receives, sorts, stores and distributes donated and purchased food and government commodities.

How does the Houston Food Bank help people affected by Harvey?

The Houston Food Bank has a history of providing disaster relief, but we have never seen devastation on this scale. The Houston Food Bank will provide food and supplies in the short term and for many months to come to residents in southeast Texas who will struggle to rebuild their lives. The Food Bank works closely with our network of partner agencies to ensure food is getting to those who need it most.

Volunteers work to sort dry, frozen and refrigerated items donated to the Houston Food Bank to ensure the product meets appropriate guidelines. All product is separated into various categories prior to distribution.
