The Philadelphia Department of Human Services (DHS) operates Philadelphia's only secure juvenile detention center, the Philadelphia Juvenile Justice Services Center (PJJSC). Youth between the ages of 13

and 20 are held here at the request of the Courts while they wait for their cases to be heard. We provide supervision, high quality programming, and an array of professional services.

The PJJSC's on-site school, individual and group counseling, conflict resolution, life skills, and supervised outdoor recreation help youth in our care to understand and develop empathy for the victims of crimes.

We provide residents with a range of services and activities designed to meet their needs, including:

- Education.
- Social services.
- Medical services.
- Behavioral health services.
- Recreational programming.

The PJJSC is a clean, well-staffed, and secure detention facility, licensed by PA Department of Human Services. The School District of Philadelphia provides education to all our residents. Any credits earned at the PJJSC are transferable back to the student's home school.

The tour will take about 3 hours round trip (taking into consideration traffic, attendees putting their personal items away when they arrive and retrieving them when departing and about 40 minutes to an hour to complete the actual tour).
